<u>Stage/Rol</u>	Listener	Co-thinker	Advisor	Partner	Decision-maker
Preparation	Young people are informed about a communication tool (WhatsApp) in the project	Young people are asked to test an online questionnaire	Young people provide feedback on the recruitment letter for recruiting participants	Young people contribute in writing an article about the aim of the project, aimed to be published in the magazine of the patient association	Young people set up a Facebook page to increase the visibility of the project
Execution	Young people are present during a project meeting	Young people are asked about ideas for interview questions that will be asked to participants	Young people provide input for a poster which will be presented by the project leader at a congress	Young people and the researcher analyze interview fragments together	Young people prepare a presentation and present this at an international congress
Implementation	Young people receive a newsletter about the project	Young people read a draft version of an infographic and give suggestions	Young people are asked about their prioritization of the implementation of products	Young people participate in a promotional campaign to disseminate the results of the project	Young people create and maintain a webpage aimed for peers who have the same disability as they have
